### **Hull primary schools set for Olympic fun success**

Rugby League stars put future young athletes through their paces

Hull F.C. Rugby League Club is hosting a special two-day FUNdamentals 2008 Olympics event for City schools. Primary schools have been asked to bring three children from Year one to Year four.

The event will test pupils skills around timing, distance and accuracy as part of a culmination of coaching support, which started in January across Hull and East Riding. The aim is to improve balance, co-ordination and agility of primary school pupils.

The schools will be representing countries across the world - wearing the respective colours and displaying the national flags. Mascot Airlie Bird will be on hand with the 'Olympic Torch' at both opening ceremonies followed by a guideline of each respective fun skills stations from the Hull F.C. Foundation Staff and Hull F.C. players.

Special medal ceremonies will award gold, silver and bronze medals with the respective national anthem being played.
